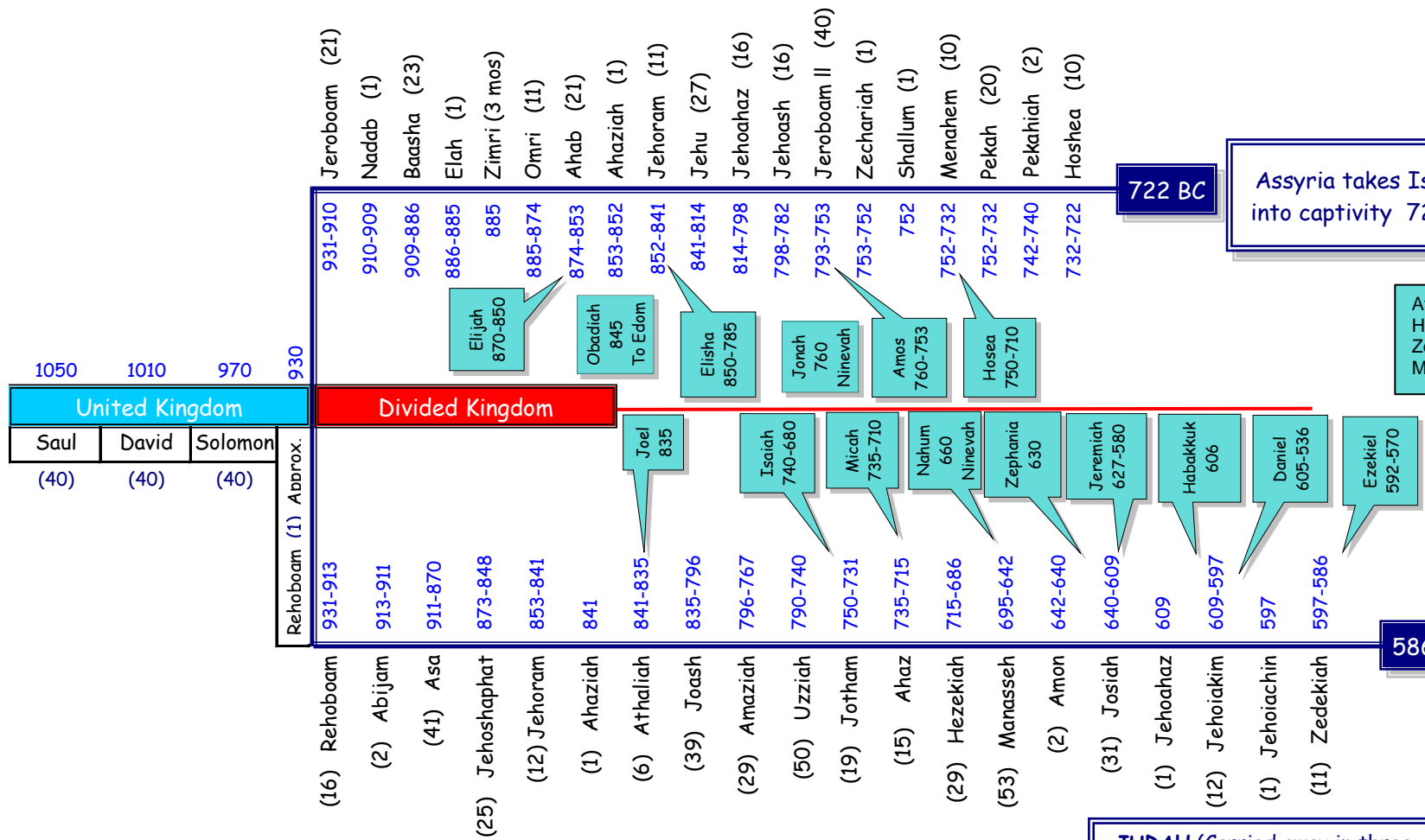

Internal strife, outside influences, are some of the issues.



722 BC
Assyria takes Israel into captivity 722BC

After the return: (Jerusalem)
Haggai - 520BC
Zechariah - 520 to 518BC
Malachi - 425BC

586 BC
Babylon takes Judah into captivity 586BC

COUNTING OF YEARS
Part of one year and part of the next year would be referred to as two years. Jewish counting was not accurate as we count the years today.

(Southern Kingdom)
Judah
931BC - 586BC

Two Tribes: Judah Benjamin

JUDAH (Carried away in three time periods)
606 BC 1st Group taken away
597 BC 2nd Group taken away
586 BC 3rd Group taken away

Captivity Period:
586BC - 539BC
Last of captives leave about 516BC (70 yrs)

Please Note: Some of the dates of the reigns of the Kings are overlapping. Sometimes the successor assumed the role due to health problems. The years referred too in the Bible relate to their own reign.
