- 11) They are hopelessly lost outside of Christ (Ephesians 2:12-13).
- 12) They have not been baptized into Christ (Romans 6:3).
- 13) Those who have not been baptized into Christ.
- A. Have no spiritual blessings which are only in Christ (Ephesians 1:3).
- B. Have no redemption which is only in Christ (Ephesians 1:7).
- C. Have no forgiveness of sins which is only in Christ (Ephesians 1:7).
- D. Will be condemned on Judgment Day since they are not in Christ (Romans 8:1).
- E. Have not become a new creature since they are not in Christ (2 Corinthians 5:17).
- F. Have no salvation which is only in Christ (2 Timothy 2:10).
- G. Have no eternal life in Heaven which is only in Christ (1 John 5:11).
