- 8) Hebrews 4:14-16 Through prayer to God we can find help in time of need.
- 9) 1 Peter 3:12 God's eyes are over the righteous and His ears are open to their prayers.
- 10) James 5:16 The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much with God.
- 11) 1 John 3:22 God answers our prayers if we keep His commandments.
- 12) Ephesians 3:20 God through His providence is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think.
- 13) Matthew 6:8 God knows what we need before we ask.
- 14) Matthew 7:11 God knows how to give good things to those who ask Him.

15) Romans 8:34 Jesus is at the right hand of God making intercession for us.

16) 1 Peter 5:6-7 God cares for us.
